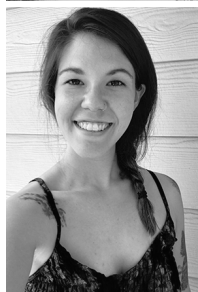
KATIE REID, MUSIC DIRECTOR
